In FC Midtjylland, we are searching for open-minded, punctual, independent, creative and dedicated person, who are searching for an opportunity turning theory into practice and who are dedicated about investing in a future career within the football industry. FC Midtjylland will both consider applicants who are currently enrolled at an educational programme or applicants who recently graduated from a relevant educational programme.

JOB DESCRIPTION SPORT SCIENCE INTERNSHIP:

 Joining our team as a Sport Science Intern, you will play a key role in generating, revising, and enhancing reports to meet the requirements of our club. Your responsibilities will span across various domains, including conducting tests (preseason and muscle testing for both our 1st team and academy teams). Collaborating with the Head of Sport Science and the Academy Sport Scientist you will assist in GPS measurements for the 1st team and academy. Additionally, you will be tasked with the preparation of the 1st team supplements, supporting the Head of Performance and Head of Sport Science during gym sessions and be involved in inhouse research projects.

TASKS:

- Sport science profile, less performance coach
- · Assisting in all testing (pre-season/muscle testing on both academy and first team)
- Developing reports following questions within the club
- Literature review based on questions within the club
- Assisting Academy in GPS measurements if needed
- Preparation of supplements (1st team)
- Assisting in testing (from U13 to 1st team),
- Assist in the gym
- Training U13-U15
- Participate in the SDU project

In the daily life, the internship students will be based at the training ground together with the academy or first team. Besides the daily activities in the club, the intern will attend a local Sports School, where the intern will get UEFA C coaching courses and learn about FCM Style-of-play, different football specialist areas, Danish football culture etc.

It will be an advantage if the internship student is fluent in English, both orally and in writing, appreciates an informal tone and has knowledge and is curious about the sport science part of the football industry. The internship position is non-paid, but FC Midtjylland will cover board and lodging. All interns are living in the IBF Arena (single rooms) next to FC Midtjyllands training ground. The start date of the internship positions is the *19th of june 2024*.
