STUDY PROGRAMME OVERVIEW

As a Research Analyst in the scouting department, you will research different markets to understand the youth/academy/senior football infrastructure and acquire expertise insights in specified countries, and produce academic papers that explain the key findings to inform scouting department investment and logistics. You'll also take part in key projects that evaluate market trends and transfer flows.
